



Gift Aid Scheme

Gift Aid is a scheme which allows the School as a charity to recover some of the tax which you, as a UK taxpayer, have already paid, or will pay, to the Inland Revenue, at the basic rate of income tax on the gross amount of each voluntary contribution you make to the School.

If you are a tax payer, by completing this Gift Aid Declaration, the school will receive an additional 25p for every £1 contributed, **at no extra cost to yourself**. This is of great value to the school. In 2020 we were able to claim back in excess of £50,000 from HM Revenue & Customs as a result of parents completing the Gift Aid Declaration and we hope this amount will increase year on year.

If you are a higher rate taxpayer, you also benefit by signing this form, as you can receive tax relief of 20% of the gross value of the contribution made by completing the Gift Aid section in your Self Assessment return.
